PLACE & TIME REQUIREMENTS

PURPOSE OF TASK (RELATIONSHIP TO THE FESTIVAL)

To involve community in shared artwork, making mural and site decorations such as sculptures. To involve community in shared skills and preservation of art and craft skills from past times. To provide people with outworking examples of 'community in action' with participation of adults of varied physical abilities and varied levels of skill in group activities.

CONCISE DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Helping people access the arts/crafts activities. For example providing and monitoring paint for the community mural, cleaning brushes, water pots etc. Teaching art and craft skills and helping teachers of these skills to run classes smoothly. Keeping the area clean and safe. Encouraging people to take part, giving good community skills and examples to visitors.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS

Interest in arts/crafts activities. Strong people skills (eg, teaching community work). Tolerance, being happy to work with people of varying skills & experience. Some skills in encouraging cooperative work also an advantage.

SPECIAL SKILLS OR TRAINING REQUIRED

Previous involvement with community art or teaching an advantage. Tolerant attitude to people with physical or mental health issues and disabilities. (Gentle assertiveness is another advantage).

ORIENTATION REQUIREMENTS

Team members are encouraged to attend the Volunteer Orientation Day prior to the Festival
